Class A



For wood, paper, cloth trash and other ordinary combustibles.

Class B



For gasoline, greases, oil, paints, and other flammable liquids.

Class C



For live electrical equipment. Water will cause a danger of severe electrical shock.

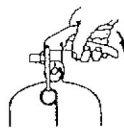
Class K



Commercial Deep Fat Fryers (cooking oil fires.)

The label on the extinguishers shows one or more of the above symbols designating the types of fires on which should be used.

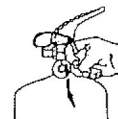
Pictographic operating instructions are shown on the label. Understand these before using the extinguisher.
